



Animals and Art

[1] In 2012, a museum in London put on a show of art made by animals. But are the animals really artists, or do we just want to see them as such?


[2] It has become common for zoos and even aquariums to offer art supplies to animals from many species. They want to keep the animals happy, and active both mentally and physically. In the National Zoo in Washington, everything from cockroaches to lions to giant pandas have 'made art'. Treats are sometimes used to encourage the animals, but staff say that the creatures take part by choice.


[3] Artists have also involved animals in their work, and the results have been impressive. One created a piece called *Honeycomb Vase 'Made by Bees'* by putting a vase-shaped structure into a bee colony. It took 40,000 bees one week to build a hive around the structure.

[4] Another piece called *Applied Design* was made by filming moths flying through the air. Their paths were followed and then all of them joined together and, with the help of 3D printing, a lamp was made.

Writing a Concluding Paragraph


The last paragraph of an essay is the concluding paragraph. This paragraph includes a summary statement and leaves the reader with a final thought about the topic.

The summary statement restates the thesis without repeating the thesis statement from the introduction. Instead, it is one or two sentences. When you paraphrase, you restate an idea using different words. To do this, you can use different words

Thesis: The city of Paris is more important than the characters in the movie Midnight in Paris.

Paraphrase: The location is the most element of the movie Midnight in Paris. It's even more central to the story than the are.

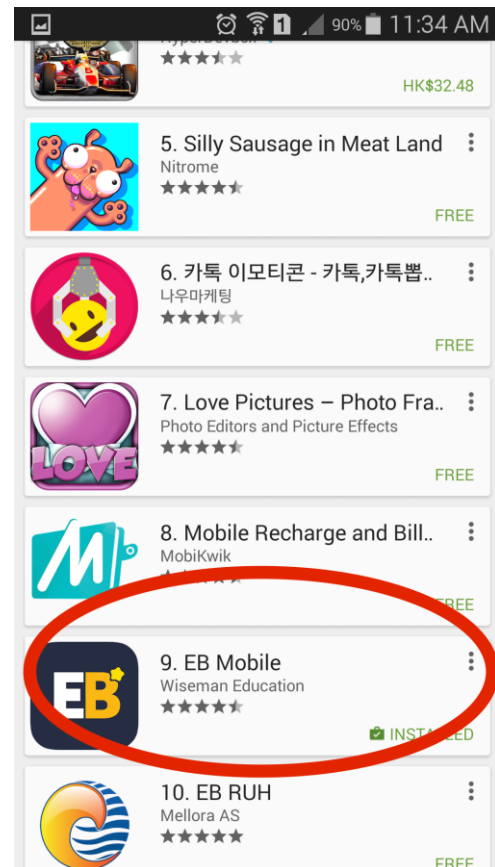
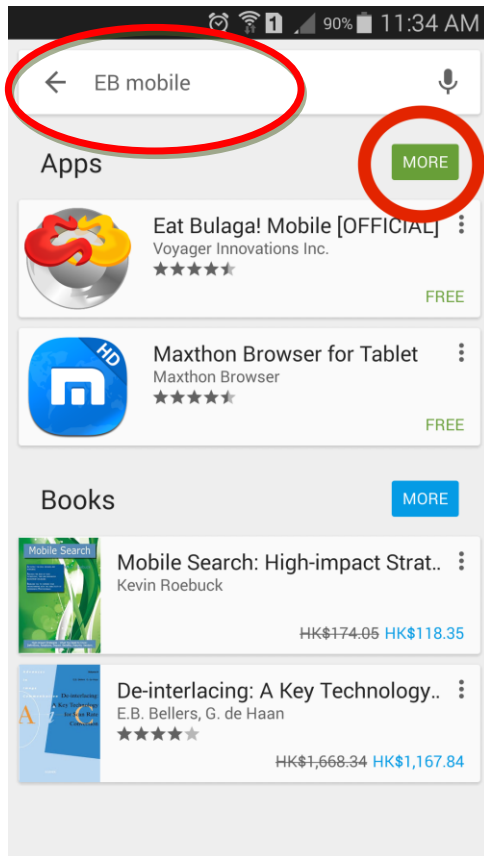
